Scholarship Eligibility Rules

Any graduating high school student who has been accepted as a candidate to a school of higher education (College, University, Vocational, Technical) is eligible to receive the scholarship providing the student meets the following requirements:

- A. Is a member of a youth league certified in the State of New York by the USBC, and is in good standing for the current season.
- B. Has bowled in a minimum of 30 games in the current bowling season.
- C. Files an application furnished by the scholarship committee giving complete information as required thereon, postmarked by April 1 of any year. The application is to be filed with the CHAIRPERSON of the SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

Two scholarships for a minimum amount of \$750 are available. If an existing scholarship at any time is rejected, refused or the grantee becomes ineligible for any reason, the Scholarship Committee may grant the scholarship to another eligible applicant.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

1. Fill out page number 2 entirely and attach a short essay on the positive effects of bowling in a Junior League.
2. Fill out your name and address on page 3 and give it to your league official with a stamped envelope addressed to the CHAIRPERSON of the SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE. Ask the official to fill out page 3 entirely. The league official should mail page 3 to the SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE CHAIRPERSON by April 1st.
3. Fill out your name and address on page 4 and give it to a school official or your counselor with a stamped envelope addressed to the CHAIRPERSON of the SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE. Ask the school official or counselor to fill out page 4 and mail it by April 1st.
4. All pages should be postmarked no later than April 1st.
5. Check with your league official and school official or counselor by March 20th to make sure all the application papers have been mailed. Thank them for their help and cooperation.
